



2019 Membership Fees

It is the policy of The Big Reveal to keep membership fees to the absolute minimum such that no-one is ever prevented from taking part on the basis of cost. The fees are used to help cover the cost of venue hire, public liability insurance, DBS check fees, fees for the use of sheet music (copyright charges), printing of tickets and flyers and in the case of The Revelation Strings, food and drink during rehearsals and concerts.

Fees are charged on a termly basis and are due at the first rehearsal of the term prior to taking part in the session. For any participants under the age of 16 we will also need a parent or guardian to submit a completed application form (downloadable from the membership section of the website). No child will be able to take part without one as this is a legal requirement in relation to safeguarding procedures.

Please also note that all members under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or nominated guardian at all times during rehearsals and concerts. Please do not just drop children off and leave them as we are not in a position to take responsibility for their safety in your absence.
